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MANAGEMENT OF VITILIGO [SHVITRA] – AN AYURVEDIC PERSPECTIVE

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ABSTRACT

Ayurveda has described various disorders which are unique as well its management also described. *Kushtha* is one of the important group of diseases which are found in daily practice. It comes under the concept of skin disorders. *Shvitra* is one of the type of *Kushtha* in which *Shvetavarnatmaka Mandala* or white patches are developed over the body. It may be characterized by *Kandu, Daha*, etc. In modern science it can be correlated with Vitiligo. It is found among 1% of the general population. Some diets are also responsible for the formation of *Shvitra Kushtha* which are said to be *Viruddha Aahara* in *Ayurveda*. In this case study of *Shvitra Roga*, its managed by the help of various *Shamana Aaushadhis*. Its effect, *Upashaya* was studied under this case study.

INTRODUCTION

Ayurveda is the science which deals with the prevention as well as

cured for the disease. This is the main aim of *Ayurveda*.^[1] In *Ayurveda* there is eight principles are mentioned which are together known as '*Ashtanga Ayurveda*' it has *Kayachikitsa* is the main and 1st branch of *Ayurveda*.^[2]

Skin is the largest organ of human body. Its size and external location makes it susceptible to a wide range of disorders. In recent years, there has been a considerable increase in the incidence of skin problems in the tropical and developing countries like India due to various reasons like poverty, poor sanitation, unhygienic, harmful chemicals, and exposure to extreme environmental conditions of cold, heat.^[3]

Manifestation of any skin disorders is one of the most socially debilitating health issues. Unlike many other health issues, so people with skin conditions can experience associated social stigma, such as lack of confidence, depression and anxiety.

All the skin diseases in Ayurveda have been classified under the broad heading of 'Kushtha' which are further categorized in to Mahakushtha & Kshudrakushtha.^[4] Shvitra Kushtha is one of the common diseases among various skin disorders. Acharya Sushruta imparts the importance of *lepa* which is one among the Bahiparimarjana chikitsa.^[5]

Shvitra is one of the *Kushtha*, which is characterized by white patches which appeared on the body region. According to *Kashyapa Samhita, Shvitra* is called as *Shweta Varniya* patches developed over the body.^[6] It is also known as – *Kilasa, Aruna, Daruna, Shweta Kushtha. Bhrajaka Pitta* is situated under the skin region and it is responsible for *Prabha* and *Chaya* of the skin.^[7] Any impairment in this *Bhrajaka Pitta Dosha* and *Vata Dosha* leads to development of *Shvitra*. It can be correlated with Vitiligo in modern science.

Vitiligo, present in approximately 1% of the population, may be associated with other autoimmune disorders, such as autoimmune thyroid disease, Pernicious anaemia, Diabetes mellitus, and Addison's disease.^[8] In this case study, *Shamana Chikitsa* like *Aamalaki, Khadira, Bakuchi Churna, Raktashodhaka Vati, Bakuchi Churna* with *Gomutra Arka,* Pigmento Ointment, *Saraka Vati* was used for the management of Vitiligo i.e. *Shvitra* and was continued for 3 months, effectiveness of the drug was shown within 3 months and a remarkable result was seen in the patient within 3 months without aggravation of symptoms and any side effects.

OBJECTIVES

To study the role of Shamana Chikitsa in the management of Shvitra [Vitiligo].

METHODOLOGY

Case report

A 15 years old male patient visited in OPD of *Kayachikitsa* having complaints of *Shwetavarniya Twakavaivarnya* near right periorbital region along with *Kandu, Daha, Shirashoola, Amlodagara* since 2 years.

Management

The effect of *Aamalaki, Khadira, Bakuchi Churna, Raktashodhaka Vati, Bakuchi Churna* with *Gomutra Arka, Pigmento Ointment, Saraka Vati* in the management of *Shvitra* [Vitiligo] is as follows in the duration of 3 months of study.

Along with the management of Vitiligo, *Pathya & Apathya Aahara-Vihara* had been properly followed by patient. *Aahara Dravyas* includes *Snigdha Aahara, Ghrita*, etc. *Pitta shamaka dravyas* are given. *Vihara* includes proper *Nidra*, avoid *Ratrijagarana*, No *Divaswapa*, etc. Also, patient advised to follows proper and regular follow up.

DISCUSSION

The management of *Shvitra* in *Ayurveda* described very well through the help of *Shodhana* & *Shamana Aaushadis*. In this case study patients' presents with the *Shwetavarniya Twakavaivarnya* at periorbital region of right eye along with *Kandu, Daha, Shirashoola, Amlodagara* this symptoms were reduced with the help of *Shamana Aaushadis* which turned white patches in to the pinkish one, then blakish and normal skin colour was achieved with three months of regular treatment. The mode of action of *Shamana Aushadhis* are as follows;

- Aamalaki, Khadira, Bakuchi Churna Decoction All three drugs are known for the management of Shvitra. This are having properties like Kandughna, Kushthaghna, Varnya.
- *Raktashodhaka Vati* It helps in purification of blood and helps to boosts the immune system of the body. It contains *Ananthamoola, Daruharidra, Manjishtha, Gorakhamundi, Triphala, Kutaki, Shuddha Gandhaka*. It helps to treat skin rashes, eczema, vitiligo, etc.
- Bakuchi Churna Bakuchi Churna is one of the important and known drug used for Shvitra. It helps to purify the blood, controls and helps to cures the skin disorders. It helps to cleanses blood & toxins, micro-organism from the skin.
- Pigmento Ointment It has main ingredient Psoralea corylifolia which stimulates melanocytes to synthesize melanin, one of the pigmentation agent. It helps to treat Vitiligo which is helps to clear the white patches present in the *Shvitra*,
- Saraka Vati Helps to cleanse the bowel movement, boosts immune power and helps to removes the vitiated *Doshas* from the body.

CONCLUSION

In this *Shvitra* [Vitiligo] Case report, patient has given *Aamalaki, Khadira, Bakuchi Churna, Raktashodhaka Vati, Bakuchi Churna* with *Gomutra Arka,* Pigmento Ointment, *Saraka Vati* along with the follow up of implementation of *Dinacharya*. The effect of *Aamalaki, Khadira, Bakuchi Churna, Raktashodhaka Vati, Bakuchi Churna* with *Gomutra Arka,* Pigmento Ointment, *Saraka Vati & Dinacharya* implementation shows effective in the management of *Shvitra* [Vitiligo] along with regular follow up of *Pathya* and *Apathya* diet.

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
