There are more than 30,000 different species of fish living in various ecosystems around the world. These are the largest group of animal under the series Pisces in phylum vertebrata. Fish is an important aquatic animal and good source of protein, vitamins,

minerals and oil and as a nutrient source of low fat, high quality protein. It is also good source of omega-3 fatty acids, vitamins D and B2, calcium phosphorous, iodine, iron, zinc, magnesium, and potassium which are essential for healthy living.

Recently, the important role of fish in the ecosystem has been undermined by over fishing and pollution by industrial activity. Such activity has caused a reduction in the population of fish and an overall reduction in health of fresh and marine biotic communities.

The study of different varieties of fish species is providing the more information about different fishes and also their marketing and their importance in economic development of country and education.

Study Area

The study site was "Local fish markets of Nanded (Tq. Nanded, Dist. Nanded, and Maharashtra). In Nanded, different fish markets, there are 4-5 fish markets which are located at different area of Nanded. They are Etwara fish market, Wednesday fish market, Friday fish market, Nagarjuna fish market, Kautha fish market etc. Out of these my study site was all fish markets which mentioned above, except Kautha fish market. I visited to fish markets on market of that area. These fish markets always open on market day and in all season and months of year, sometimes closed in exceptional cases. Daily fish market open at afternoon to evening.

Nanded district is situated at bank of Godavari River, therefore good water source is available and it makes favourable environment to fish marketing.

Structure of Fish Market

In Nanded there are two types of markets are present, regular and weekly fish market. There are 4-5 fish market which located at different place. Two fish market are daily present, one located at Etwara, near Choufala (i.e Etwara fish market. Another located at Hingoli naka near Nagarjuna hotel (also called Nagarjuna fish market. Remaining fish market are weekly markets, and fish sold on market day of that area in which, The Wednesday fish market (Tarodanaka, Nanded) on wednseday, and other one is Friday fish market (Gokulnagar, near railway station, Nanded) on Friday. The Etwara fish market is both type daily as well as weekly. The weekly market on Sunday. All these markets are 2-3 km from each other. In Nanded fish market fresh, frozen and dried fish are sold or marketed. Generally 80% fresh

fishes are marketed somewhat frozen and dried fish are marketed. Generally 20-25 stalls are found in open place in market day, but in daily market it is less in numbers are 4-5 stalls found. Fish seller are comes from Bhokar, Umri, Mudkhed and some local seller of Nanded.

Supply

In fish market of Nanded, fishes are brought or supply from Godavari river, Devapur dam, Karla, Amdura, Jawapur and also from wholesaler. Some seller are directly captured fishes from above water sources, and some seller buy the fishes from wholesaler (in wholesale market) and sold them. In fish market, the seller which sold fishes in large quantity called wholesaler while the person who buy the fishes from wholesaler and sold at local fish market called retailer. In Nanded the Etwara fish market is wholesale fish market from which the fishes are supplied to retailler and other small fish markets of different villages for selling.

Price of Fishes

In Nanded fish market fish price is fixed. In market fisherman/seller is retailer (small market).and they decide the price of the fishes. Fish price decide by the market demand.Generally the price of fish depends on market structure, location, fish species, quality, size and weight of fish. The price is also influenced by supply and demand. There are generally seasonal variations in prices. The fish price is highest in summer which shown from the survey of the fish market. We know that, price of fish is also dependent on the size of the fish which available in market. In Nanded fish market there are large sized as well as small sized fishes and also medium sized fishes. The price of large sized fishes is high while the price of small sized fishes is less. From the survey of fish market is found that the. Catla, rohu, maral, and baam fishes are highly costed.

b) Fish meals

Many fishes are dressed and cooked. They are dried; fishes are made into fine powder. This is called meal. It is used by weak and convalescent people.

c) Isinglass

It is a pure gelatine substance. It is obtained from air bladder of fishes. It is used to clarify wines.

d) Fertilizers

The fish waste materials have more calcium, protein, phosphorous and other substances. These materials are grinds into powder it is used as fertilizer to grape gardens, coffee and tea plants.

Controlling disease

Some of the fishes like Gambusiabarbus will eat the larval forms of mosquitoes. Thus they prevent the spread of malaria disease.
